Algoma Rules in Packerland

KEWAUNEE — The Kewaunee Indians dominated the play on the field, but Algoma owned the scoreboard as the Wolves beat their arch rivals for the first time in 15 years, 20-7, here Friday night and claimed the Packerland Conference title.

Kewaunee rolled up 293 yards to only 124 for the Wolves, but the Algoma defense made the big play when it had to and capitalized on Indian mistakes in notching the win, winding up the season with an 8-1 record compared to a 7-2 log for the In-

Kewaunee was still in the contest until late in the fourth period when Algoma's Pat Boucher intercepted an Alan Schlies pass and returned it 79 yards for a touchdown which sealed the Indians fate with 1:35 to play.

Mistakes also led to Algoma's other two touchdowns. On the opening kickoff Kewaunee overran the kick, had to go back and pick it up and were downed at the three-yard line.

Starting from the hole Kewaunee got six yards on a Jerry Selner first down run, but on the next play, a motion penalty put the ball back at the four. On third down the Indians quick punted and Algoma took over at the Indian 33.

Six plays later Algoma quarterback Roger VanLanen hit Kurt Holtz in the right corner of the end zone with a sevenyard scoring toss and then booted the extra point for a 7-0 lead.

Late in the frame Algoma was forced to punt and Kewaunee's Joe Augustine bobbled the ball. Algoma's Norm Oshefsky came up with it at the Kewaunee nine.

Four plays later, on the third play of the second period, VanLanen banged in from the one on a quarterback sneak. The kick failed.

From then until the interception return, Algoma never really threatened.

Kewaunee however came back strong and late in the first half drove to the Algoma seven before a five-yard penalty put them back on the 12 and four Schlies passes fell incomplete and the Indians coughed up the ball to Algoma.

On the Indians first possession in the second half they went from their own 36 to the Algoma 16 but lost the ball on downs when Schlies was thrown for a loss on a fourth-and-two situation on a bootleg play.

The Indians finally got on the board with 11:02 to play in the game when Schlies connected on a nine-yard scoring pass to Greg Rabas to cap a 23-yard drive which was set up on a short punt and a 15-yard penalty on Algoma for piling on.

After the kickoff Algoma was forced to punt but Kewaunee fumbled the ball away on its first play at its own 33. Algoma drove to the seven where VanLanen tried to salt it away with a 23-yard field goal but the kick was wide right.

Kewaunee took over at the 20 with 4:25 to play and drove down field steadily for what could have been a tying or winning touchdown . . . that is until Pat Boucher interfered. Kewaunee made a valiant attempt after Boucher's clincher but the time ran out on the Algoma 10.

The Schlies-to-Rabas combination accounted for the bulk of the Indians yards. Schlies hit on 13 of 26 attempts for 177 yards and Rabas caught 11 for 140 yards. Two of his passes he lateraled off and turned into even bigger gains.












Another major event is the Educational Tour. This is something that every FFA member looks forward to. We will be visiting the Magison-Milwaukee area.


