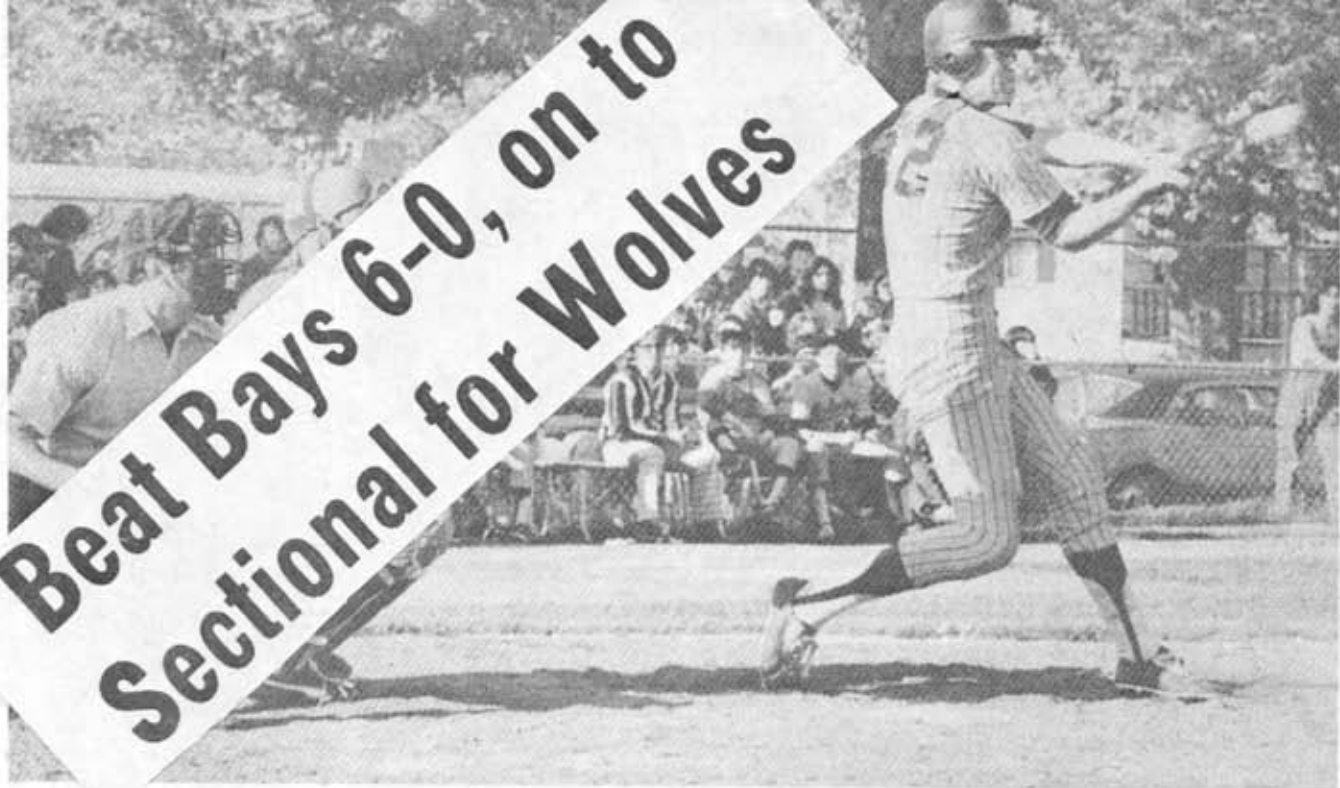

Shaky Start Costs Algoma

Algoma got off to a shaky start, giving up four runs on three hits, three errors and a wild pitch, in the first inning and lost 6-3 to Appleton West in the WIAA Appleton baseball sectional semi-finals at Goodland Field Thursday.

Ron Van Lanen, who gave up five hits, struck out seven and walked four, suffered the loss while Jeff Coenen was the winner, also allowing five hits. He fanned eight and walked five.

In the other semi-final Little Chute scored two runs on two hits in the top of the 15th inning to oust Shawano 3-1. The two winners meet this afternoon for the sectional title and a trip to the WIAA state finals.

Algoma took the lead in the top half of the first inning when Tom Parkas walked, stole second and Todd Kirchman singled with two outs.

But in the bottom of the stanza the Terrors, who have won the state title the past two seasons, scored all the runs they needed.

Coenen drew a walk, advanced on a balk, stole third and scored on a pickoff attempt that went into left field. Kirby Krueger then reached on an error and went to second on the play and scored the second run on a Tim McGuire single. With two outs Scott Schuldes singled and then the Terrors pulled off a double steal. Another run scored on a single and the final run on a wild pitch.

Algoma closed the gap to 3-3 with single runs in the third and fourth. In the third Parkas scored when Van Lanen grounded out. In the fourth Parkas singled home Scott Schiesser who reached on an error and advanced on a Pete Guth single.

The Terrors made it 5-3 with a run in the bottom of the fourth when Coenen singled home Dean DeWitt who had reached on an error and stole second and wound up the scoring in the sixth when pinch runner Mark Otto scored from third on a sacrifice fly by Ron Cork.

Algoma threatened in the top half of the sixth, stranding two runners.

In the Little Chute-Shawano contest, the Mustangs' Ron Tiedt reached first on an error in the top of the 15th and advanced to second on an infield single by Kevin Wyngaard. The runners advanced to second and third on a wild pitch and then scored when Scott VandenHeuvel hit a slow roller to deep second base for a single.

Shawano had tied the score in the bottom of the seventh, forcing the extra innings, when losing pitcher Tony Wilber tripled and scored on a wild pitch.
