Wolves Knock on State Door

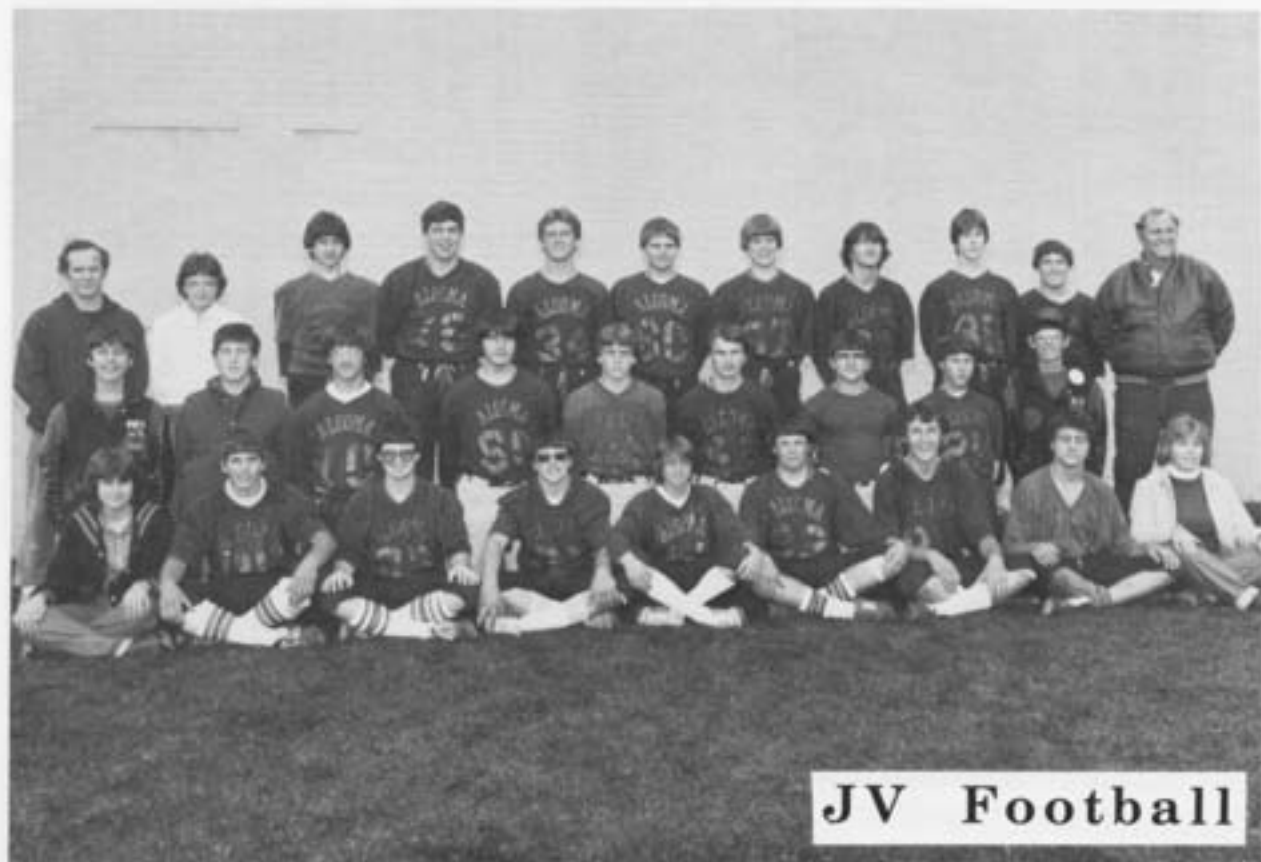
The 1982 football season started with a tough 4 way scrimmage against GB Southwest, Kaukauna, and Ashwaubenon. The season opener, a non-conference game against Plymouth gave the indication that the Wolves would be a solid football team, as Algoma defeated the Panthers 14 - 0. The conference opener put Algoma in a catch up role for 4 weeks as the Eagles defeated Algoma on a last minute field goal 12 - 9. Regrouping the following week Algoma pounded Sturgeon Bay 39 - 0. Denmark blocked a punt which led to an early touchdown against the Wolves. But the Wolves settled down and racked up 31 points for a 31 - 6 victory. The next 3 games were on the road. First, playing arch rival Kewaunee for their Homecoming, the Wolves were constantly stopped as Kewaunee carried a slim 6 - 0 lead into the 4th quarter. With 4 minutes left in the game, Algoma started a drive from their own 9 yard line and 13 plays later a touchdown and go ahead extra point.

Luxemburg Casco also selected the Wolves as their Homecoming opponent. Leading 14 - 0 at half Algoma's offense exploded for 27 points to put the Spartans away 41 - 0. Algoma played its second non-conference game against a team that it had not played since 1948 - Racine St. Catherines. The game was televised and despite giving St. Catherines a touchdown, a 76 yard run on the second play of the game, Algoma hung on for a 12 - 7 victory. This set up the show down with Mishicot for the conference championship - a rematch from 1981. It was Algoma's Homecoming as well as dedication night for former assistant coach, Gaylord Mauer, who had died in May, 1982. The Wolves led 14 - 0 at half and downed the Indians with a final score of 36 - 0.

The new conference champions earned the right to participate in the state playoff tournament with their first opponent being 2 time state champions, Two Rivers. The Wolves played well, forcing 5 interceptions and 1 fumble, but they trailed 15 - 13 going into the 4th quarter. Two Rivers exploded in the final minutes of the 4th quarter for 3 touchdowns and defeated Algoma 35 - 13.

At the end of the season, Jeanne Barta again lead the conference in both scoring and rebounding. She also become Algoma's girls all-time leading scorer, breaking the 1000 point barrier and ending her career with 1078 points. Jeanne was placed on the all-conference 1st team for the 2nd straight year. Terri Schmiling, who was honorable mention last year, was voted to the 1st team all-conference this year.

How cold was it? It was so cold . . .

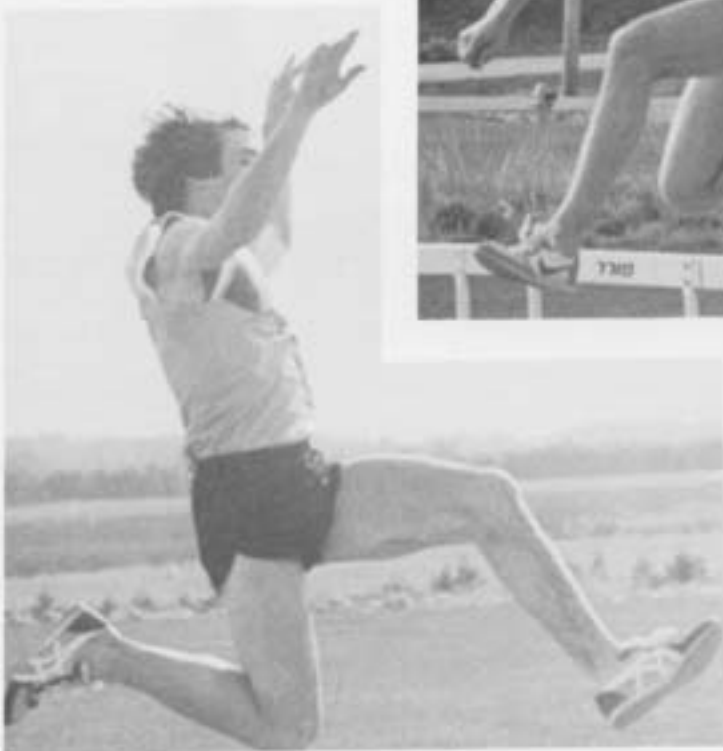
