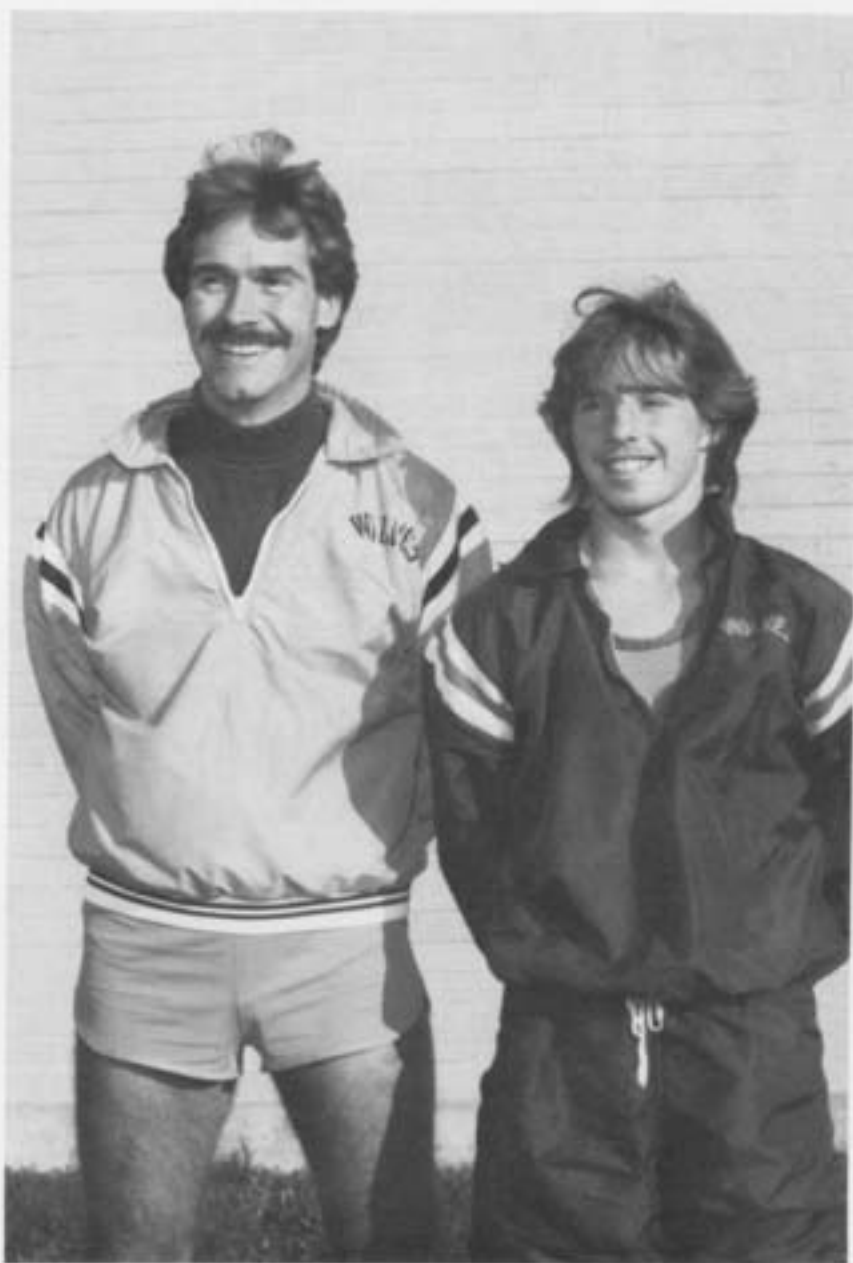

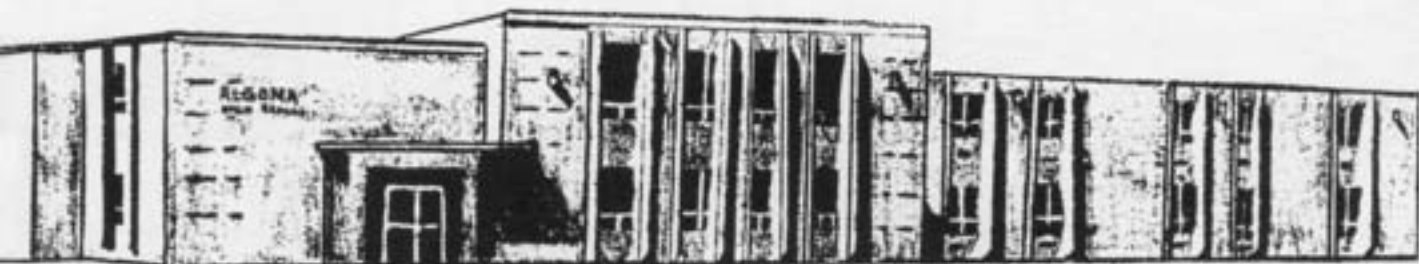

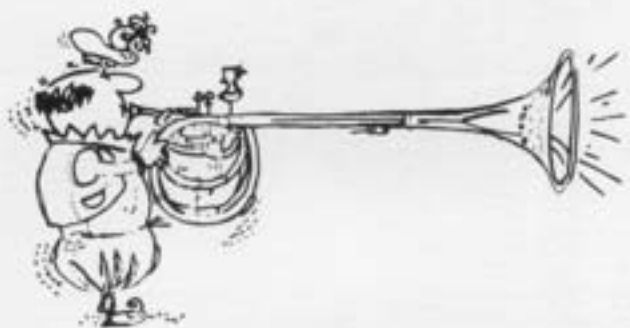

Winning streaks were continued and records began to tumble as the Algoma Track Teams completed one of their finest seasons ever.

The boys team completed their second straight season without a dual meet loss but were unable to capture their second consecutive conference crown. Kewaunee narrowly defeated both Algoma and Sevastopol for the title. Phil Schmidt and John Kroll finished the conference schedule with only one loss each, both finishing second in the Conference Meet: Schmidt in the shot put and Kroll in the 100, though John came back later to win the 200 and continue his unbeaten string in that event. The 400 meter relay team consisting of Mike Delorit, John Slaby, Eric Mayheu, and John Kroll lowered the school record in that event while winning at the regional meet.

One of the oldest records on the books was erased when Liz Blahnik ran 1:02.5 in the 400 meter dash, eclipsing the mark set by Maree Schmitz, set in 1976. Lori Mueller continued her assault on the record board, breaking the shot put record three times, finally ending with 39'7". Lori also broke her own existing record in the discus by three feet, upping the standard to 119'.

The boys' team was crowned Sectional Champs and qualified five athletes for the state meet in five events: John Kroll 100, 200; Mike Delorit 110 HH; Phil Schmidt shot put; 400 Relay team of Delorit, John Slaby, Eric Mayheu, and Kroll.

Lori Mueller advanced to state as a winner in the Sectional shot put and runner up in the discus, while Colleen Panger earned the trip with her second place finish in the shot put.

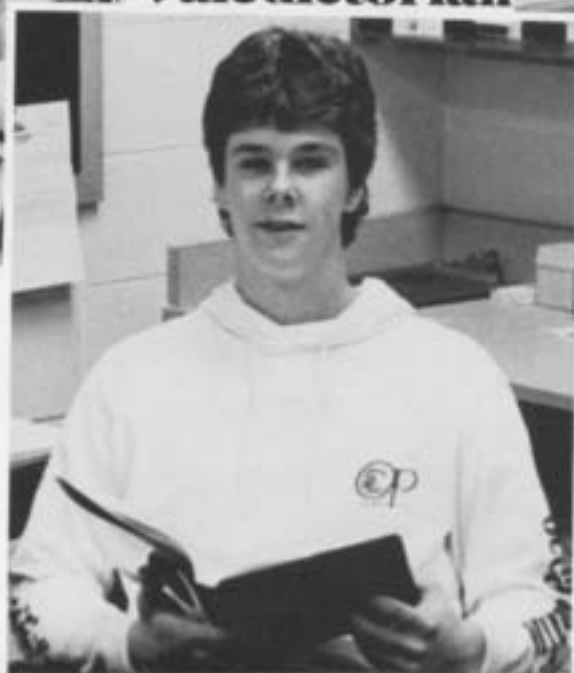
