The 1986 football season was not an easy campaign. Fielding only three seniors, the young Wolves suffered eight losses while winning only one; the homecoming game with Sevastopol-Gibraltar. Practice started with only 18 players, but increased to 30 by mid-season. Youth and inexperience were very evident in a rugged, well balanced Packerland Conference as five teams: Sturgeon Bay, Southern Door, Oconto, Oconto Falls, and Kewaunee all tied for first place.

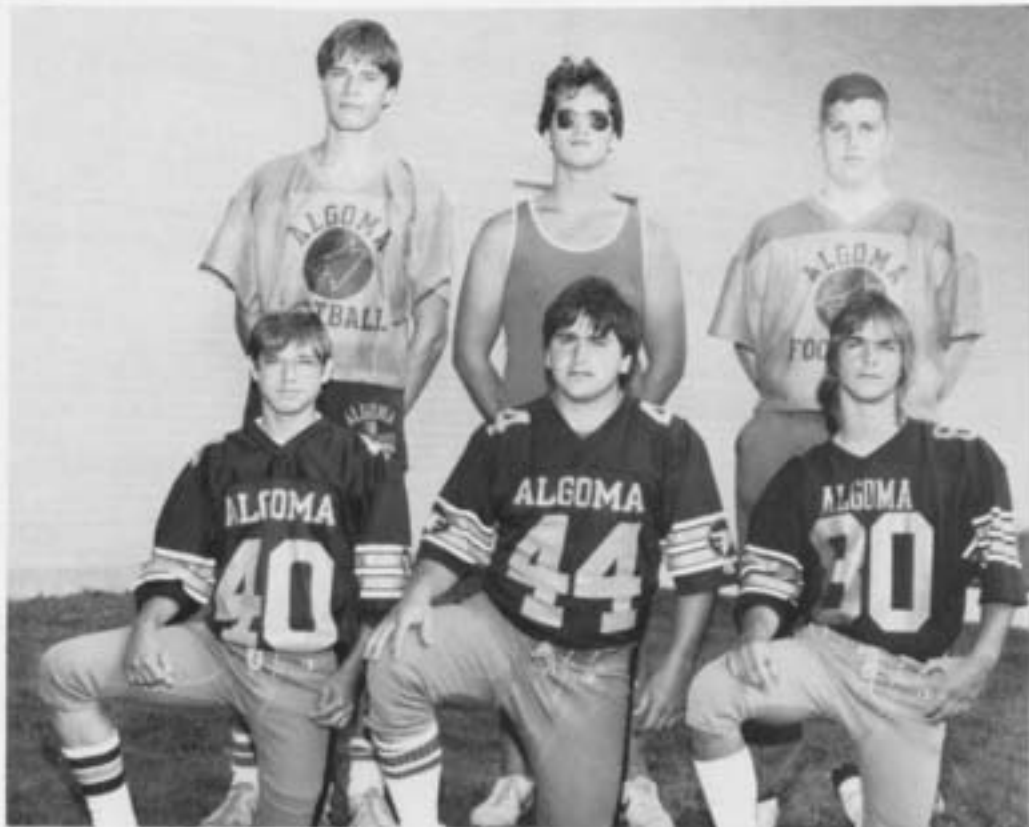
Algoma opened the season against two non-conference opponents, Valders and Denmark, before taking on a tough Southern Door team. The running game remained in hiding, leaving the first games which resulted in the offense using a one-back offense. The Wolves passed the ball more in one game than they had during the entire previous season.

The Wolves' best game of the season, although a losing cause, was against Oconto. The showdown of the year came against Sevastopol-Gibraltar as the Pioneers invaded Perry Field as the Wolves homecoming opponent. After three and one-half quarters, the Wolves finally scored after Todd Wech recovered a fumbled punt on the 10 yard line. Sevastopol responded by marching the length of the field to score. On the two point conversion attempt, Sevastopol-Gibraltar was stopped just short of the goal line.

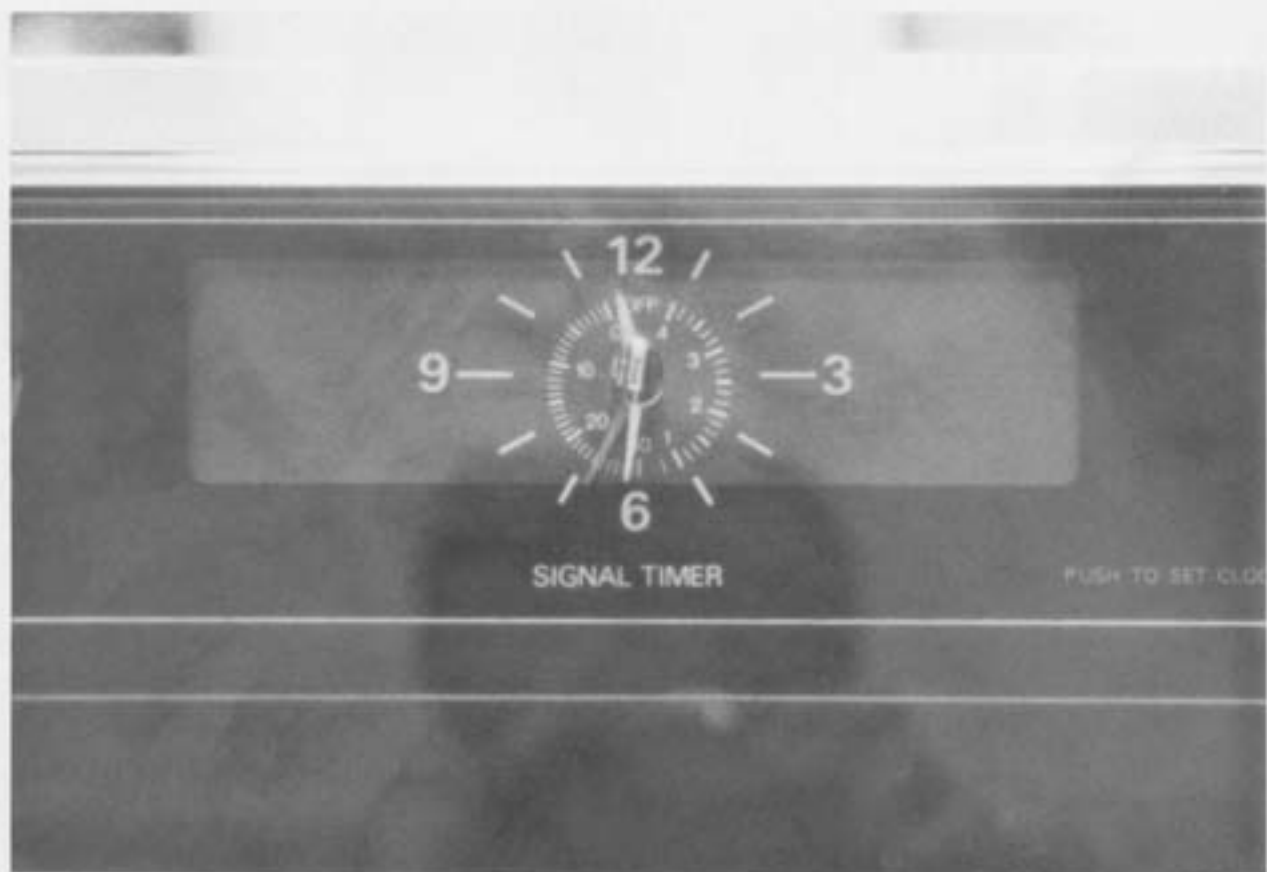

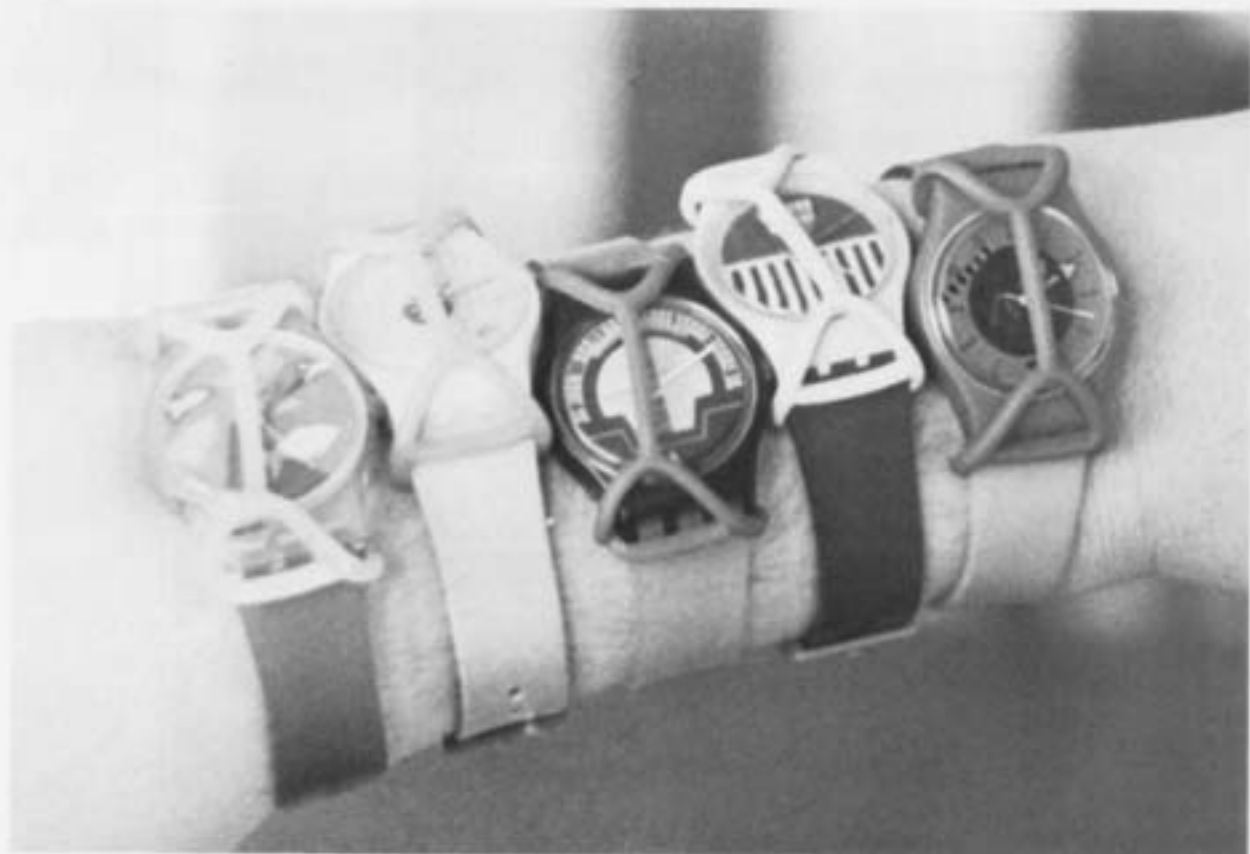
