Algoma received some rough treatment from Denmark as the Vikings man handled the Wolves 25-0. The conference opener against Southern Door was a wild and exciting game. The lead exchanged hands only to end in a tie 20-20 at the end of regulation time. In OT, Guth intercepted an Eagle pass to set the stage for Mark Wyss, AFS student from Switzerland, to kick the winning field goal. Oconto Falls scored on the first play from scrimmage and proved too quick on a wet rainy night. Traveling to Lux-Casco resulted in a long night for Algoma as they were stymied by the Spartans. Picking up the pieces, the Wolves prepared for arch rival, Kewaunee. In the fourth quarter, behind the running of Haack and Kroll, Algoma drove the length of the field to score. Beckman's interception and touchdown sealed the Indian's fate. Oconto's Blue Devils gave the Wolves a tough opponent for the homecoming game. Behind 0-6 in the fourth quarter, the Wolves, sparked by a 36 yard punt return by Dart, started a drive. Mueller threw a 23 yard pass to Beckman to the one, Haack scored and Wyss provided the go ahead EP.

The wolves had to hang on in the closing minutes to win 7-6. Traveling to Fish Creek, the Wolves dominated the S-G Pioneers 20-8. The final game of the season found the Wolves locked in a see-saw battle with the Sturgeon Bay Clippers. Tied 7-7 at the half, the game appeared headed for another OT, when an intercepted pass was fumbled, recovered by the Clippers on the 12 yd. line which led to an eventual score and victory.

The Wolves finished with a winning season, first since 1982, and tied for 3rd in the conference behind Oconto Falls and L-C. All conference first team selection was David Kostichka at DE, who also was selected on the All-Region team. Second team, Jay Beckman at DHB, John Kroll at IL, Paul Mayheu at LB, and Mark Wyss as kicker. Kostichka was MVP. Beckman and Guth were co-captains. Dick Zimmerman was Best Blocker and Pete Haack was Best Tackler.

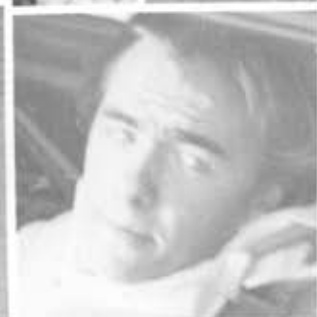

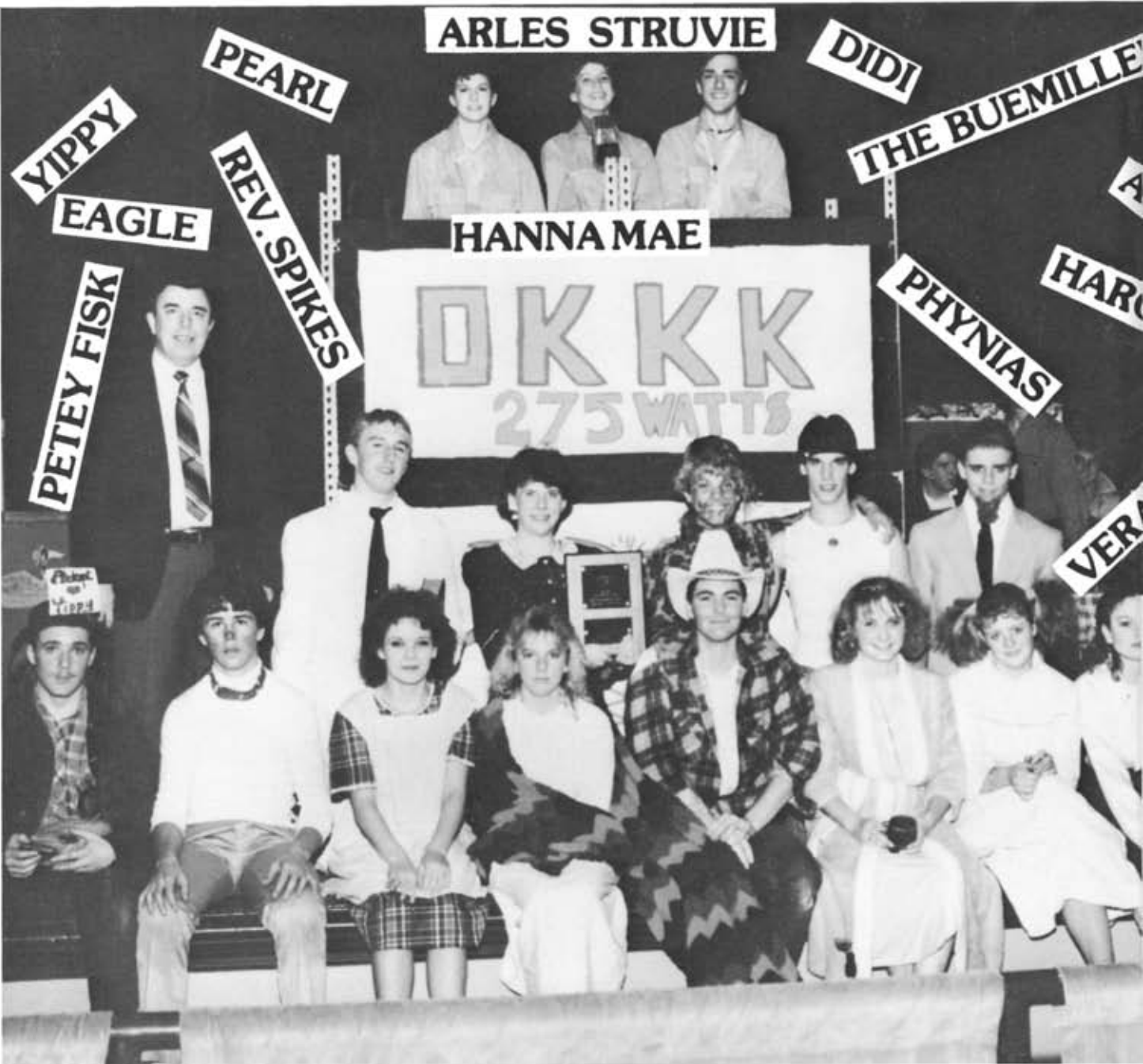

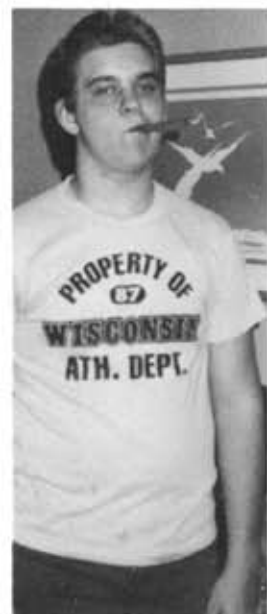
