The 1988 football season found the Wolves involved in many close and exciting games. Algoma struggled in the first two non-conference games losing to the M and O conference champs, Crivitz, 13-7 and the Olympian co-champs Denmark. But the second game provided the fans with an indication of the game plan for the season as tailback Pete Haack gained over 100 yards rushing. The league opener against the Packerland champs, L.C., was a strong defensive battle with the Wolves finally losing 17-0. Parents' Night found the Blue Devils of Oconto and the Wolves in a tight game that wasn't decided until the final minute when the Oconto QB threw the ball out of bounds which sealed the victory for Algoma, 14-13. Traveling to Fish Creek to play S-G, Algoma jumped to an early 15-0 lead led by the hard running of Pete. Dominating the game, the Wolves chalked up their second victory 21-8. Arch rival Kewaunee invaded Perry Field and the Wolves and the Indians played a tough defensive game. Although leading 7-0 late in the 4th quarter, Algoma fell to the Indians as they scored on an 82 yd. run, scored the two point conversion, and returned an intercepted pass to hand the Wolves a heart-breaking loss. Picking up the pieces, Algoma traveled to Oconto Falls for their Homecoming and aerial circus. Playing their best game of the year, Algoma came from behind to score the winning TD with a minute left in the game. Homecoming saw the St. Bay Clippers and their huge line take on the Wolves. Falling behind on a slow whistle/stolen ball play, Algoma battled back to tie only to lose in the final two minutes of the game. The final game of the season was played on a Thursday night at Southern Door. Algoma played a gritty determined game but were unable to stop the running game of the Eagles. The highlight of the game for the Wolves was when Pete Haack gained enough yardage to put him over the 1000 yard mark. He finished the season with 184 carries for 1043 yards.
