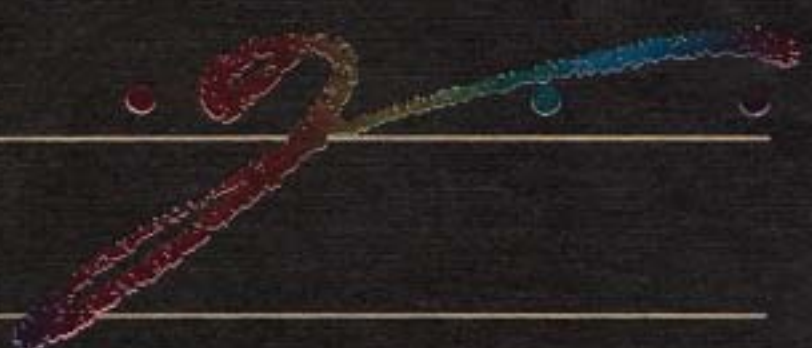

The 1991 football season was a very competitive season for our Wolves team as they finished 3-4 in conference, and 3-6 overall. The season marked the return of three teams. (Frosh, JV, and Varsity) to competition and Mr. Mayheu returned to the sidelines after a one year absence.

The Varsity team hosted the four-way scrimmage with Coleman, Shiocton, and Brillion, one week prior to opening the season against Crivitz. 39-0 but they rebounded to play a better game before dropping a close game to Denmark, 16-8. Conference play opened with a show as the Wolves jumped on S-Q 35-6. Cory Paape hooked up with Jeff Groessl on the second play from scrimmage for a TD. Kevin Panger started his assault on becoming the conference's leading rusher with 157 yards and three TD's. Traveling to Oconto Falls, Algoma was ambushed early by the Panthers and never recovered losing 44-7.

Powerhouse Southern Door lined up at Perry Fiels the following week and demonstrated why they were co-champs of the conference, as they handed the Wolves a 34-0 shutout. Algoma shut down the Eagle's running attack, but could not stop the Aune-Birmingham air connection. Sturgeon Bay on a wet-windy Friday night put together a 94 yard drive in the 4th quarter to come from behind and hand the Wolves a heartbreaking 18-12 defeat. Returning to the friendly confines of Perry Field, the Wolves picked on the Oconto Blue Devils intercepting six passes enroute to a 22-6 victory. After an enthusiastic and highly successful homecoming week, Algoma hosted the L-C Spartans. Scoring early, the Wolves went on to post a 20-0 shut out. The final game of the season was against traditional rival Kewaunee. The Wolves played a tough physical game but lost to the conference co-champs

14-0.

Post season honors included: Kevin Panger leading the conference with 710 yards; and the offense and defense finished 6th overall. All conference honor included Kevin Panger, first team offense and defense, Jeff Groessl second team offense and Paul Wallace second team defense. Team honors included MVP Kevin Panger, Best Blocker Paul Wallace, Best Tackler Kevin Panger and CoCaptains were Cory Paape and Jeff Groessl.

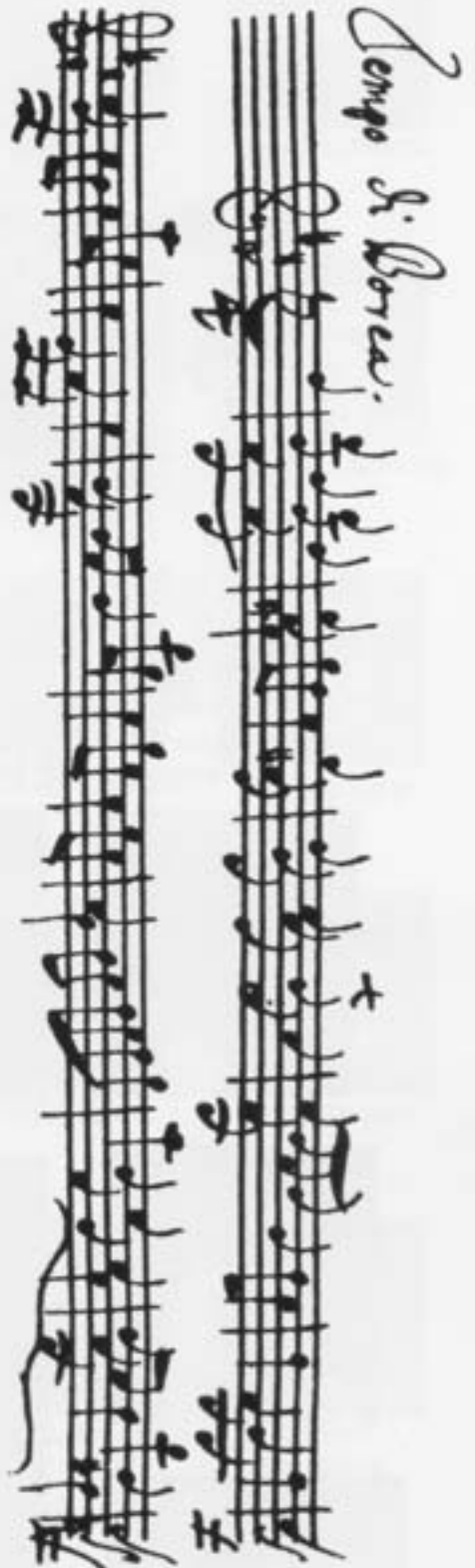

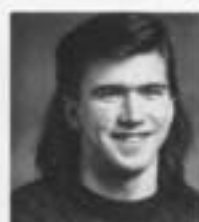

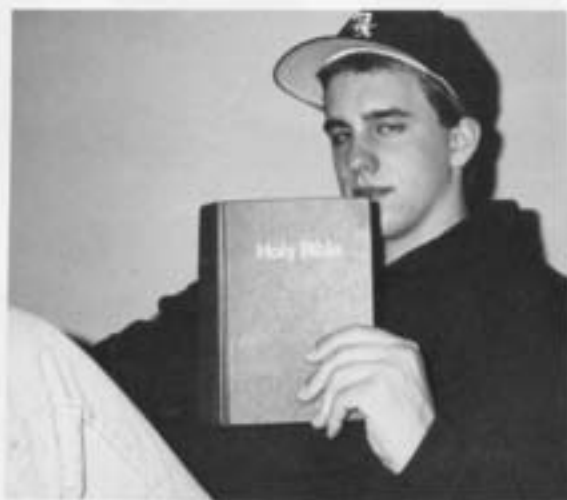
