Going into the 92 year, the team was picked to finish in 4th place. They started off slow with a 13-6 loss to Manty Lutheran which they lost Troy Breitlow in the first quater. With a rearranged offensive line, they entered the Denmark game hitting hard, but losing because of many penalties. The first conference game started with a 28-0 blowout of Oconto Falls. The Wolves entered the next week with an exciting 14-12 come from

behind win over Kewaunee. Against Southern Door the Wolves lost a 7-6 hard fought game. The Wolves rushed for almost 400 yards in a 20-12 victory against Oconto in the homecoming game. The Wolves got sweet revenge against Sturgeon Bay in a 7-6 thriller in Sturgeon Bay. Kevin Panger went over 1000 yards in a 28-0 breeze passed Sev./Gib. in which the Wolves won the conference title and earned a trip to the WIAA Football playoffs. In the first round of the Division 4 playoffs the Wolves romped to a 40-14 victory over Howards Grove. In the next round, the Wolves played Mayville, who averaged over 30 points per game and shut out almost all their opponents. The Wolves put up a tough fight but lost 21-7 because they ran out of time at the end.

All Region honors went to Kevin Panger as a running back and linebacker and Scott Gartrke as a Defensive Tackle. Jason Renard broke the reception record for Algoma High School with 28 grabs.


