The 1993 Algoma football faced a major rebuilding as only three starters returned from the '92 championship team. Working into shape, the team opened with an explosive 38-0 victory over Manitowoc Lutheran and set the tone for the rest of the season. Denmark rallied in the fourth quarter to give their coach, Jerry Leiterman, his 200th victory as the Wolves fell 19-14. The Packerland Conference opener found the pre-season favorite Oconto Falls Panthers, at Perry Field for a tough, physical game in which the "Black and Gold" won 27-6. Traveling to Kewaunee for the 100th game of the rivalry, the Wolves controlled the scrappy Indians with a 20-0 win. Southern Door, another pre-season favorite, ambushed the Algoma team as it attempted to defeat the Eagles on their home turf, only to fall 23-0. Picking up the pieces, the Wolves returned home to take on the L-C Spartans. In a see-saw battle, Algoma scored in the final minute, set up by a 42 yd pass/catch, to take an impressive 22-15 victory. The wind and rain did not dampen the fireworks provided by the Wolves as the rolled up 500 + yds in a 54-14 blow out of Oconto at the new field of the Blue Devils. The Wolves were in good shape as Sturgeon Bay came to town for the '93 homecoming game. But the talented Clippers displayed their skill and power in a 34-0 victory. Algoma closed out it's season with an impressive ground game at Sevastopol with a strong 27-15 victory. Algoma finished 3rd in the conference with a 6-3 record.





It was supposed to be a major rebuilding project, but the 1993-1994 season turned out to be just a reloading project for Coach Bruce Romdenne. After losing Kevin Panger and Ben Romdenne, who combined for nearly 1,800 varsity points, to graduation, things looked rather bleak. That bleakness was quickly erased with the emergence of talented underclassmen in Brian Nell and Peter Schmidt along with the Senior desire to win in Dan Luedtke, Barry Schoening, Jason Haegele and Joe Riederer. Algoma won their first game for the first time in seven years with a win over Wrightstown. Wins over Southern Door and Hilbert were sandwicked in between a loss to Denmark. After a loss to Sturgeon Bay at home, the Wolves showed their promise with a shocking upset of Oconto Falls in the Wolves Den. Before Christmas, Gibraltar was pummeled and Shiocton made a valiant comeback to beat the Wolves on the road. The Big Wolf Machine was undeterred as wins over L-C, Oconto, Sevestopol, Southern Door and Kewaunee made the Wolves into a legitimate title contender. A crushing defeat at Sturgeon Bay set the Wolves back, along with the loss of Luedtke to an ankle injury in a win over Gibraltar. Without him healthy, Algoma lost to Oconto Falls, Kewaunce and L.C. Wins over Oconto and Sevastopol closes out the regular season. During tournament play, Algoma lost to a powerful Reedsville team by six after leading by nine early in the fourth quarter in a regional quarterfinal. The loss of the seniors will be a big hurt, but Matt Carmody and Chad Dequaine, who both showed brilliant bench play, along with the Twin Towers should make the Wolves a possible favorite to win the Packerland Conference for the first time in 20 years in 1994-1995. Algoma has become a premier program in the league the past three years, winning 44 games overall in that span.
