The 1998 football season was a great example of many individuals becoming one team. Led by a close-knit group of seniors, the Wolves posted a conference record of 5-2 and an overall record of 6-4. This inexperienced and undersized team that was picked to finish at the bottom of the Packerland Conference surprised everyone but themselves and qualified for the playoffs.

The season started with an impressive 35-6 victory over Manitowoc Lutheran. Ryan Klessig and Steve Gartzke racked up 300 yards rushing behind Algoma's overachieving offensive line, consisting of seniors Aaron Schuster, Casey Buhr, Greg Hafeman, Gio Patterson, and Jesse Rye. That game was followed by a 33-14 loss to Denmark.

Algoma opened their conference schedule with a three game winning streak. The victories came over Oconto, L-C, and S-D. People began to take notice of the Wolves. Algoma followed with consecutive losses to state powers Southern Door and Oconto Falls. Then came the highlight of the season. The seniors had never beaten long time rivals Kewaunee and this was their last chance. Algoma's inspired defense led by Ryan Klessig, Joe Tuttle, Tyler Tassoul, and James Tebon destroyed Kewaunee in the second half leading to a 21-16 victory. The conference final against Sturgeon Bay typified the Wolves' season. School records were set by Jesse Duerst for tackles in a game (28), and Casey Schoenberger for passing yards in a season (1,181).
